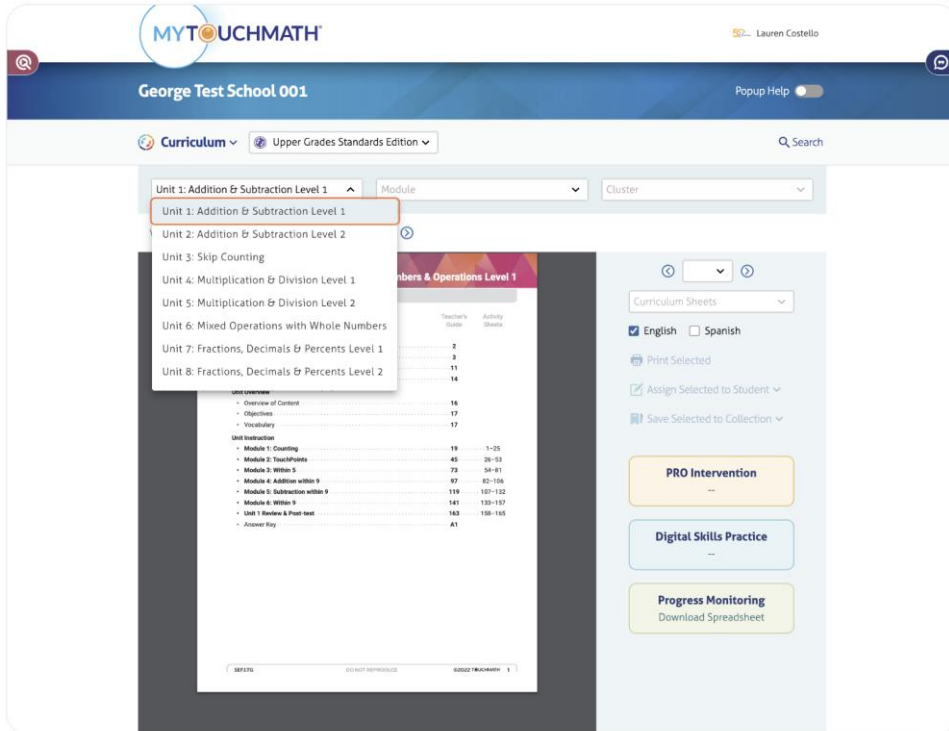

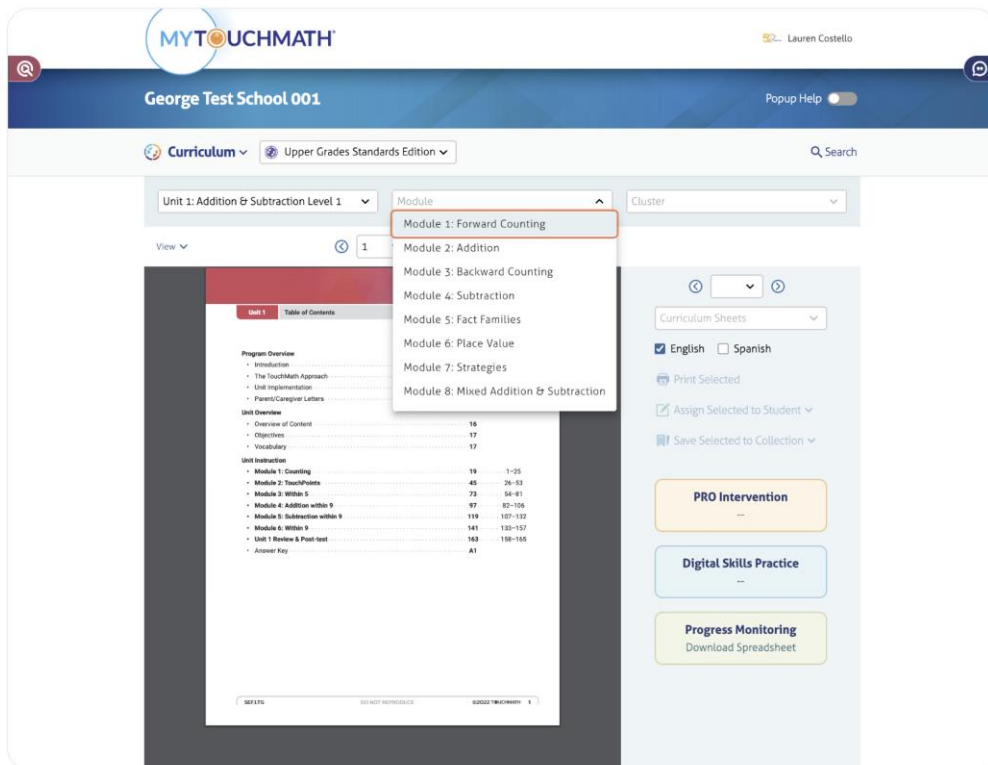

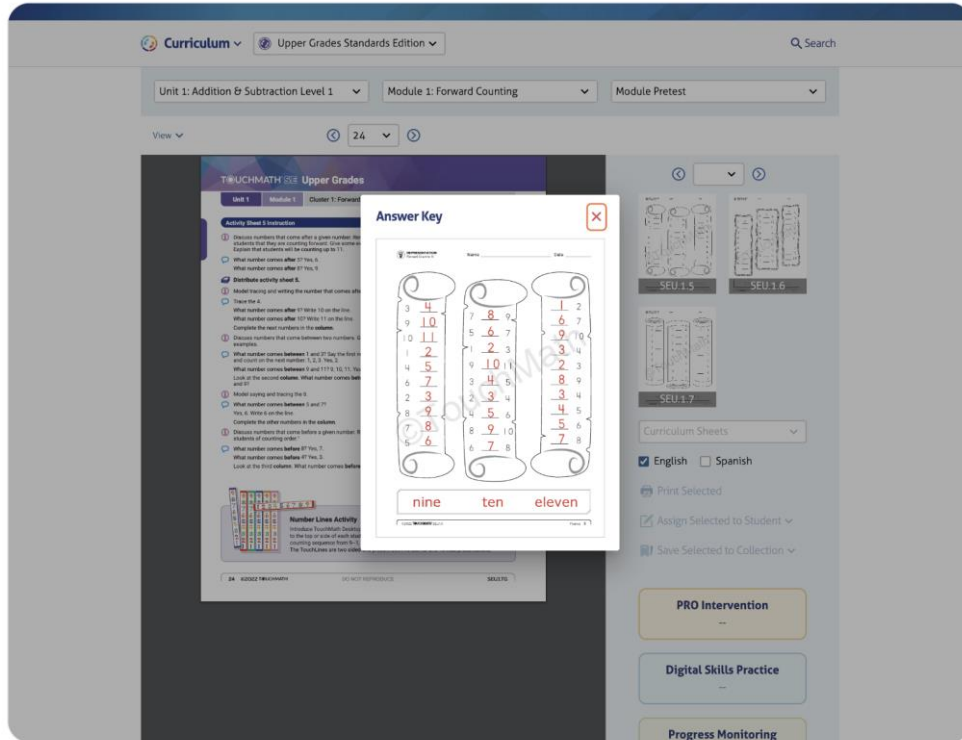
6 Last, select a cluster

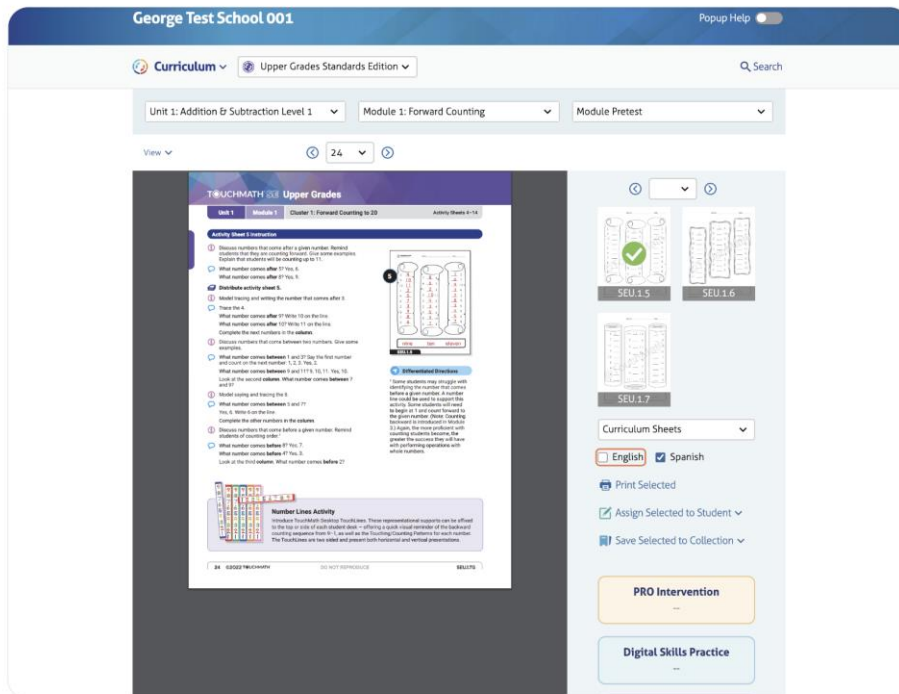

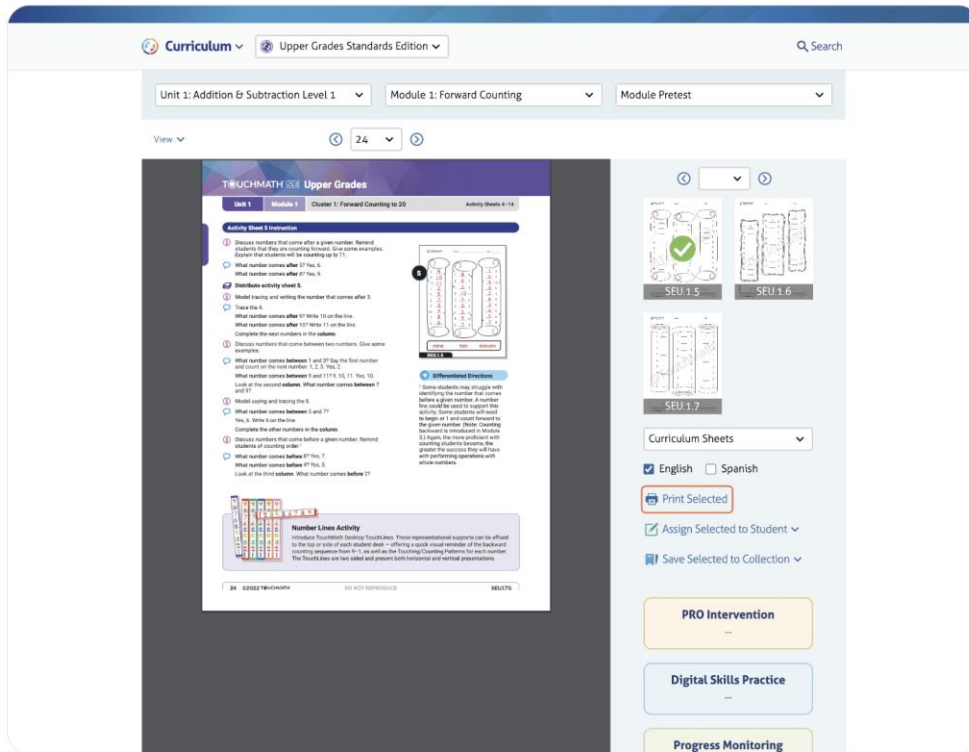

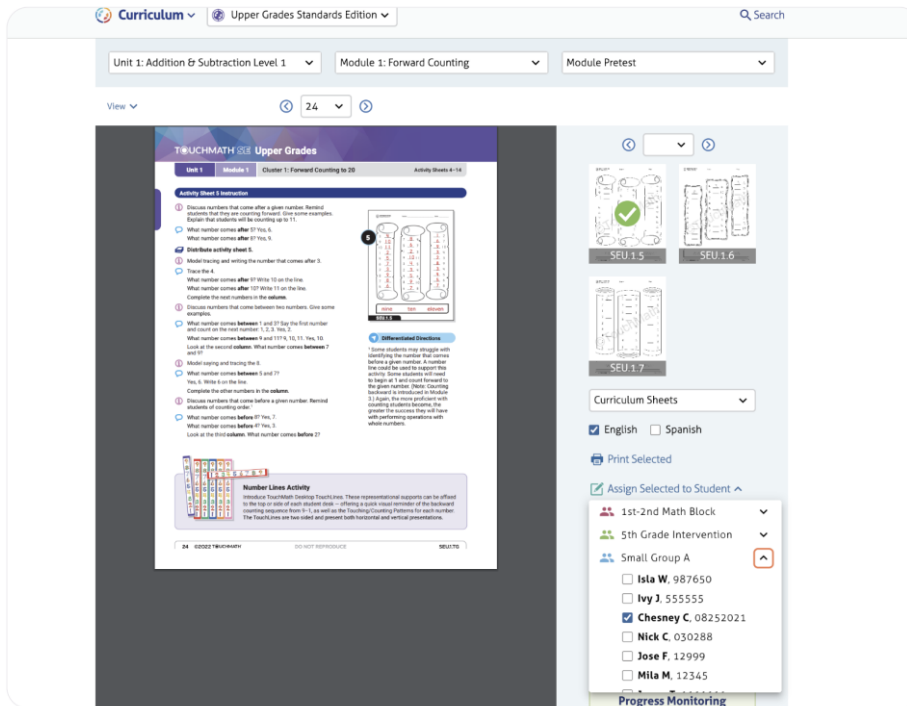
